March 15 - 17, 2024 | Boch Center Wang Theatre

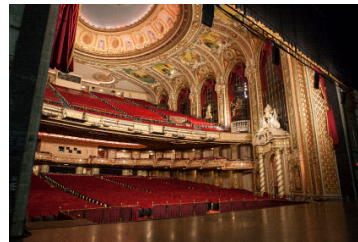

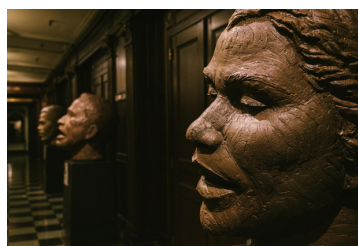


### The Wang Theatre Stage
